Great Lakes & Natural Resources Camp

There's still lots of space available for campers to attend 4-H Great Lakes & Natural Resources Camp. The camp includes going charter fishing on Lake Huron for first-time campers; returning campers get to do really cool inland fisheries stuff and go on a special night hike. This camp is an annual MSU pre-college program held July 31 to August 6, 2011, for teens ages 13 to 15 on July 1 or entering 8th to 10th grades next fall.

Recognized for program excellence, in late 2008 the 4-H Great Lakes & Natural Resources Camp was named a National 4-H Program of Distinction, which recognizes the highest quality 4-H youth development efforts in the nation. With that award, 4-H GLNR Camp became eligible for consideration and was selected in 2009 for the 4-H Natural Resources Conservation Education Award. The award is given jointly by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and National 4-H.

In addition to tons of fun and fond memories that will last a lifetime, this camp provides teens from across the state the opportunity to:

- Improve their knowledge about Great Lakes and natural resources ecology and management issues.
- Increase awareness of environmental problems, foster environmental stewardship and enhance involvement in local natural resources projects.
- Increase interest in the outdoors, develop leadership skills and self-confidence and influence career decisions.
- Enjoy quality camp activities, gain hands-on science experiences, meet new people and develop friendships.
- Learn from natural resources and youth development experts and develop possible career interests.

Where is Camp?

Camp Chickagami is located along Lake Huron in the northeast corner of the Lower Peninsula in Presque Isle (between Rogers City and Alpena.) The state-licensed camp has dormitory-style housing, small cabins, a dining hall, and toilet and shower facilities. Meals will be prepared and served in the dining hall by a qualified cook.

How Much Does Camp Cost?

The fee is \$335 for campers who are 4-H members and \$345 for campers who are not 4-H members. This includes meals, snacks, lodging, a T-shirt, and program and activity fees. Donors to the Michigan 4-H Foundation, Michigan Sea Grant Extension and the Michigan Charter Boat Association generously offset about 26 percent of the real \$450-

per-camper cost!

A limited number of state scholarships are offered for teens with financial need. Contact your county MSU Extension office to see if local scholarships may also be available.

How To Apply and Remit Payment

Camper applications and deposits (\$100 for 4-H members; \$110 for applicants who are not 4-H members) are due May 16 to county MSU Extension Offices. The remaining \$235 payment is due by June 13, 2011, along with additional forms that will be sent in a camper acceptance letter.

If space is still available after May 16, late enrollments will be accepted with a \$25 late fee until camp fills or until June 10, 2011, whichever comes first.

State 4-H Poultry Palooza

When: Saturday, May 21, 2011 here (New Location): Clinton County Fairgrounds. Do you have 4-H members who enjoy raising market broilers for fair? Help them take their 4-H Poultry project to the next level by participating in the State 4-H Poultry Palooza Broiler Contest. 4-H members purchase 25 cockerels between April 4th and April 9th (families can share a flock), they keep records on the birds as the project progresses, on May 19th they take their final weight and determine the best 3 birds from the flock to bring to Palooza on May 21st. Records are turned in, the birds are presented to the judge live, judged and then harvested and the meat is judged (all in the same day).

GCFFY Camping Information

At the April Gratiot County Fair for Youth Board of Directors Meeting, the board approved funding the addition of 20 campsites by selling ten year prepaid leases through their 2020 Camping Lease Campaign. The new campsites will increase the fair's camping capacity to a total of 150 campsites.

"We will offer sites first to the 55 exhibitor families who are on our fair's campsite waiting list," states Brian Gardner, Fair Coordinator. "These new campsites will allow more individuals to experience the full fair experience." Gardner reported if the 20 sites are not purchased by waiting list families, existing campers will be able to purchase a ten year lease on their campsite until the fair reaches twenty total leases.

The projected cost of the project is approximately \$24,000. Funding will come from the 2020 Campsite Lease sale and from \$4,000 of the fair's general fund. The leases will be based on the 2011 fair campsite rate of \$100 per year for a total cost of \$1,000.

The new campsites will be located on the south side of the fairgrounds. Campers who do not want a campsite for the full ten years, have the right to sell their remaining lease to a new family.

The fair will start construction as soon as final approval for the site plan comes back from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality.
