# Fair Entry Forms - DUE JUNE 15<sup>th</sup>!!

Anyone planning to exhibit in the Gratiot County Fair for Youth must complete a Fair Entry Form. Many exhibitors have or will complete a preregistration livestock form. These exhibitors must also sign up on the Fair Entry Form. Forms are available on-line at www.gcffy.org or by pick up at our office. Fair Entry Forms correspond with our annual fair book. Exhibitors need to look for the classes they want to exhibit and put in the department, division, section, and class of all the classes they plan to exhibit or show. Livestock Exhibitors must sign up for at least their market class and the species showmanship class for their age group. Anyone selling in an auction sale will need to pay special attention to the parent's name section in the Fair Entry Form. This information will be put into the fair's database and will be used for sale programs. Be sure to NEATLY list the names you want printed for the public. If for some reason an exhibitor does not want his/her parent/guardian's name listed, please contact the fair office.

# **Parking Passes**

Parking Passes are available for presale this year at a reduced rate from those purchased from the gate. Weekly passes purchased from the fair at the MSU Extension Office are \$12.00. and will be available early June. At the gate they cost \$15.00. Daily passes will still be available and can be purchased for \$5.00 at the MSU Extension Office or upon entry to the fairgrounds.

# **Fair Royalty Information**

Senior and Junior court applications are due by June 15. Applications are available on the <a href="http://www.gcffy.org">http://www.gcffy.org</a>website and in the MSUE Office. The Senior Court will consist of a King, and his runner-up, and a Queen, and her runner-up. The Junior Court will consist of a Prince, a runner-up, and a court member, and a Princess, her runner-up, and a court member. The King and Queen will represent the GCFFY at various activities and receive a scholarship towards school or a 4-H/FFA/Fair activity.

#### **Livestock Insurance**

All exhibitors will automatically have livestock insurance on their market animals and horses. Market livestock exhibitors will have a small amount deducted from their fair checks (\$2.50 for beef/feeder and \$1.50 for goats, sheep, swine, and per small animal lot). Horse exhibitors will be covered through the Gratiot County Horse Developmental Committee. This insurance will cover the exhibitor starting with the loading of the animal into the trailer and will proceed through the end of fair or until the sale of the animal (at which time the insurance benefit will transfer to the buyer). Anyone with a possible claim must contact the fair office as soon as possible and should document their situation.
